

FARMINGTON EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH ENDOWMENT FUND
SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND DISBURSEMENT POLICY

Applicant eligibility requirements:

Applicant shall be a current member of Farmington Lutheran Church or have a direct, close working relationship with the church.

Applicant must be attending an accredited Lutheran College or seminary. Applicant in an undergraduate program must be enrolled as a full-time student. Applicant may be required to supply an acceptance letter from said institution, if a first year student. An applicant shall give the Endowment Committee permission to verify their enrollment with their institution.

Eligible applicants may apply annually for consideration.

It is at the final discretion of the Endowment Committee to determine if an applicant has successfully met these requirements.

Scholarship Disbursement:

Scholarship payments will be made directly to the Lutheran college or seminary within the school year for which the student has applied, but it is at the discretion of the Endowment Committee as to which semester(s) the payment will be applied.

It is at the discretion of the Endowment Committee as to how available funds will be distributed amongst approved applicants.

The Endowment Committee has the authority to withhold funds if the student does not meet their obligation of maintaining student enrollment in good standing.

The Endowment Committee has the authority to withhold allocated funds if the student does not maintain their membership status or close working relationship with Farmington Lutheran Church.

The FLC Endowment Scholarship is a one year scholarship that is not automatically renewed. Students need to apply each year to be considered for additional scholarships.
